Just a few years ago only a few hundred players put up the \$10,000 entrance fee to play in the World Series. In 2007 over 10,000 players are expected to participate.

The challenge for the beginner or moderately experienced player is to understand the basics - when the odds are in his favor, or against. A number of critical factors are at play. CardShark2 uses a breakthrough technology to accurately determine the winning percentage of a given hand, and then adjusts that percentage based on other critical factors such as table position and number of opponents. With very little input from the player, CardShark2 provides immediate feedback and guidance.

CardShark2 is available at www.cardshark2.com where a free trial version may be downloaded for preview. This 15-day trial provides most of the functionality of the full retail version, with the exception that play is restricted past the Flop. CardShark2 is designed to support tournament and cash games, No Limit, Table Limit and Pot Limit. There is a special Tourney Module that provides an opportunity for the risk-taker to play a particularly exciting style of tournament play. Lots of going all-in with this approach! Also included with CardShark2 is the Custom Report Generator. As the player hones his skills working with poker simulation software, he may track his progress through custom reports that are built on the fly. This detailed reporting tool will clearly indicate opportunities for growth, as well as strengths. The player can determine if he plays better from a given position, or if there is a holecard combination that causes particular challenges. Hundreds of combinations of statistics are available through the CardShark2 Custom Report tool.

The New Millenium Software Team is proud to deliver this innovative approach to learning Texas Holdem. "The feedback we've received tells us that CardShark2 provides an incredible value to the beginning and moderate player. But we think there are opportunities to do even more with CardShark2, and we are dedicated to use player feedback to drive enhancements that will be provided as free future updates", said Steve Krieger, Executive Producer for New Millenium Software.
