

Brazil to Be England's First Challenger At The New Wembley Stadium: Experts Say Book Rooms Early

For the first time in 7 years, London will play at home in Wembley Stadium. With 2 weeks to go before the game, UK hotels are still plentiful, but experts say they will fill rapidly.

May 16, 2007 (FPRC) -- The FA has confirmed that Brazil will be the first opponent England faces in the newly renovated and world renowned Wembley Stadium. Both the June 1st face-off between the two teams and the completion of Wembley are events highly anticipated events for the people of England and football fans as a whole.

The new Wembley Stadium, originally slated for completion in August 2005, will be mostly finished by June 1st for the London v Brazil games. Wembley's construction company, the Multiplex Group, says that final details of the construction project such as cleaning will take an additional three months.

The FA and Europe's football fans are anxiously awaiting the opening and willing to overlook details in order to hold the London v Brazil match in the new arena. The event will mark the first time that England has played in Wembley in 7 years.

"Brazil is one of England's favorite competitors. The convergence of this intense match-up along with the opening of Wembley is sure to be an event that fans will not soon forget," says Marcel Stillekens, founder of EuroBookings.com, the popular European hotel bookings company.
