In these events, the patient should consult his prescribing doctor
- Aggressive drug-seeking behavior like doctor-shopping, going from one doctor to another complaining of whatever malady one thinks will earn them Soma from a physician.
- Frequent periods of illness and irritability. Soma dependence and withdrawal can make a person ill for a day or two until they can find more, which restores them to seeming normalcy until they run out again.
