

Army.net Survey Asks Army Hopefuls To Share Their Questions and Concerns

A new survey developed by Army.net asks what questions and concerns potential enlistees have about joining the US Armed Forces.

The survey asks questions such as 'What are your primary questions or concerns about joining the military?' and 'What are your primary concerns about joining the military?'
