"The builder or developer that is not incorporating sustainable features will be behind the market demand. We are now at a point of determining the furthest extent to which sustainable building practices can be integrated based on market demand, selling/renting prices and budgets."

The question is how will planning and architecture actually influence the lifestyle choices that lead to sustainable "living" not just a sustainable "building," Texter asks. "Planning communities based on a core that supports the adjacent living will have a different impact on our lifestyle than the recent past. Whether this adjacency is either vertical or located across the street, differing uses are no longer seen as non-compatible. Furthermore, not only are these uses compatible but they are harmonious and should exist as one in a sustainable living environment. The focus has broadened from the sustainable building product to the sustainable community to the sustainable city," Texter said.
