The Musikfest Berlin opens for a new concert season with performances from the 2nd to 21st September 2010.

August 4, 2010 (FPRC) -- This year they are presenting 37 internationally renowned soloists, with 27 high-class ensembles, orchestras and choirs. The festival will be held at a number of venues around Berlin, including the Philharmonie, the Konzerthaus, Gendarmenmarkt and the Gethsemanekirche. The event lasts for 20 days.

Musikfest Berlin will see 24 concerts performed, with more than 60 pieces of work by 25 composers; a very impressive programme of events. There are many other conductors and composers who will be performing works by Prokofjew, Ravel, Stravinsky, Bartok and many more.

This music festival has been organised by Berliner Festspiele and Stiftung Berliner Philharmoniker who once again will put on wonderful concerts for those that attend. The orchestra is playing in the Philharmonie, Haus der Berliner Festspiele u.a., Berlin.

Concertgoers will be pleased to hear that on the eve of the festival the Keller Quartet is playing a complete performance of Bach's Art of the Fugue. They will also be featuring works by Richard Wagner, Igor Stravinsky and many more.
