His focus on respect and self-empowerment fits right in with Skyline's core values, and we felt it was important to help our employees feel confident, no matter what they may face,” said Stephanie Miller, Special Projects Manager at Skyline Exhibits and Graphics .

The class was well received by those who attended. It allowed Skyline to take a short break from designing trade show displays St. Louis to learn life saving techniques as well as have a good time with coworkers and colleagues.
