"Trading can be time consuming; even if you know everything there is to know about the markets, you can still become overwhelmed, particularly in today's markets."

The new section is the latest in a long list of improvements to <http://www.spreadbets.org.uk/>; the site recently released a huge range of trading guides which followed a redesign of the site in February.
