Of course, a lot of traders who utilise this form of analysis combine it with fundamental analysis when spread trading.

The new review breaks down into a dozen sub-sections. In the commodities markets, the section analyses moves in the price of gold, silver, coffee, oil and natural gas. In the FX market, the section looks at fluctuations in the EURUSD, USDJPY, GBPUSD and USDCHF exchange rates. The stock market section looks at the Dow Jones, S&P 500 and NASDAQ 100.

"We felt it was important," Price added, "to ensure that we offered technical analysis for a broad range of markets. Whether you're speculating in the commodities markets, the forex spread betting markets or on stock market indices, we're aiming to cover the latest price trends.

"We separated the daily review into 12 subsections on <http://www.spread-betting.org> in order to ensure that spread traders can focus on their chosen market. However we also ensured that these subsections were consistent, which meant that any trader who was speculating on more than one market could switch between the pages with ease."
